Unleashed is a longstanding biennale exhibition project at Artisan Gallery, drawing together a select cohort of early-career Queensland craft and design practitioners and launching their careers. Exploring the convergence between craft and design, Unleashed has been instrumental in launching some of our state's best talent. In this years iteration of *Unleashed 2022: Fresh Meet* (and for the first time), there has been a co-curated overview from across regional Queensland. An invited curatorial panel of arts educators, curators and practitioners from 5 different regional communities nominated one exemplary early career practitioner from their region. Artisan staff worked with colleagues from: HOTA, NorthSite Contemporary Arts, University of the Sunshine Coast, Mackay Artspace and University of Southern Queensland, to select this years Unleashed artists.

RESEARCH STATEMENT



Background: Within the visual arts, not only has there traditionally been a divide between art and craft but also a barrier between regional and metropolitan practices, with more exhibition opportunities for emerging artists living in metropolitan areas (Australia Council, 2021). In turn, there is much to be explored in re-negotiating the value of regional craft and design within the broader contemporary art sector as exemplified by practitioners who began their careers as regional Queensland artists such as Jay Younger.

Contribution: 'Unleashed' is a longstanding biennial exhibition at Artisan, Brisbane, that involves a new external curatorial panel in 2022 from five regional communities that nominated an emerging practitioner from their region. This approach enhances the profiling of early career Queensland regional artists who explore the convergence between craft and design in their artwork. Craft techniques such as needle felting in the artwork 'Billy Goat Gruff' by Ellie Coleman became an exemplar of contemporary art and its capacity to hold currency in global conversations around the use of animal fibres in craft.

Significance: 'Unleashed 2022', involved a by-invitation curatorial panel representing key regional galleries and universities; Home of the Arts (Gold Coast), NorthSite Contemporary Arts, University of the Sunshine Coast, Mackay Artspace and the University of Southern Queensland (UniSQ). The exhibition received recognition from both craft and critical art communities, with the artwork by UniSQ artist Ellie Coleman being the face of the show. The exhibition was externally funded through Arts Queensland and Artisan, Queensland's peak body in craft and design.
