On behalf of the BHI 2012 Organizing Committee, it is our great pleasure to welcome you to the inauguration meeting of the IEEE-EMBS International Conference on Biomedical and Health Informatics in Shenzhen.

BHI is a new Special Topic Conference recently launched by the IEEE Engineering in Medicine and Biology Society (EMBS). This Special Topic Conference – Biomedical and Health Informatics (BHI) – is name after an EMBS flagship transaction, of which the title will soon be changed from IEEE Transactions on Information Technology in Biomedicine to IEEE Journal of Biomedical and Health Informatics starting from Jan. 2013. BHI intends to provide a unique forum to examine enabling technologies of devices and systems that optimize the acquisition, transmission, processing, storage and retrieval of biomedical and health information for preventive medicine, early detection, early diagnosis and early treatment of diseases. It is also opened for reporting clinical studies on the novel application of health information systems.

BHI 2012, held at the Shenzhen Convention and Exhibition Center on 5-7 Jan. 2012, focuses on the theme "Global Grand Challenge of Health Informatics" and has received 325 submissions (including invited abstracts) from near 40 countries/regions. The Final Program comprised of a total of 285 oral/poster presentations and 5 special workshop/forums contributed by representatives/panelists from 35 countries/regions.

The inaugural meeting of BHI is held in conjunction with the 8th International Symposium on Medical Devices and Biosensors and the 7th International Symposium on Biomedical and Health Engineering, with joint sponsorship by the IEEE-EMBS, the Key Lab of Health Informatics of Chinese Academy of Sciences (HI-CAS) and the CAS-SIAT - Institute of Biomedical and Health Engineering (IBHE), and technically co-sponsored by the Healthcare Information and Management System Society (HIMSS), HIMSS Asia Pacific and The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). The committee would like to particularly thank the support of the Keynote and Invited Speakers, each of whom will be introduced in the next section. We are also grateful to the R10 EMBS chapters for promoting the conference, all reviewers for their high-quality and efficient feedback, all session chairs for keeping the schedule on time, the members of the Hong Kong-Macau Joint EMBS Chapter, Dr. Lei Wang, Mr. Y. P.
