The exhibition resulted in again being invited to be part of the Western Sydney University initiative, the Paint the River Project, in Moree, with an invited group residency and exhibition. This is an ongoing research project from 2021 to 2023. The 2021 exhibition was supported by an accompanying full-colour 80-page catalogue publication and the current 2022.

RESEARCH STATEMENT



When the Night Comes Solo Exhibition at Alexandra Lawson Gallery

Background


Australian artists Arthur Streeton and Tom Roberts demonstrated a long tradition of *en plein air* practice that involved processes of transferring the light encountered in nature through sketches and paintings completed in the artist's own studio. There is much to be explored in interpreting the immediacy of contemporary landscape through this approach and the impacts of studio environments upon individual artist experiences.

Contribution

The original paintings and ceramic works in the solo exhibition, When the Night Comes, are a direct response to making en plein air work. Working firstly in the field and then creating new works in the studio as a response to these initial landscape studies provides a unique platform for distilling the experience. The memory of the experience painting in the landscape while working in the studio initiates innovative ways of abstracting the landscape imagery. This exhibition also explores the uncommon process of 'nightscapes' as a counterpoint to daylight painting, often associated with en plein air representations.

Significance


This exhibition was well received with attendance of over 200 visitors at the Alexandra Lawson Gallery, Toowoomba, with further invited exhibitions being held in Lethbridge Gallery, 2020, 2021. These follow-up exhibitions, What if the Sky Doesn't Fall on Us and Places We Go involved high profile artists, Naomi White and Leisl Baker at Latrobe Gallery, Brisbane. This salon-hang created a new landscape experience for the viewer which built upon the original exhibition When the Night Comes.




